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Reminder of Care Options Available to You

Did you know, where you go for your healthcare makes a difference? Depending on where you receive care, you may pay nothing out-of-pocket!

Preventive Care - No Cost to You

Preventive care services from a Preferred Provider are payable at 100% of Reasonable Expenses, no deductible, no Calendar Year maximum, and include:

- ·Routine physical exams
- Well child care including routine exams & laboratory tests recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics
- ·Routine colonoscopies, mammograms, & electrocardiograms (EKG)
- ·Routine immunizations
- ·Many services for pregnant women or women who may become pregnant
- ·Breast cancer genetic test counseling (BRCA) for women at higher risk

Preventive Care: 100% coverage at a Participating Provider

Office Visits - More Cost

If you have a new issue or ongoing health condition, your primary care provider can help to keep you healthy.

Office Visits: 80% coverage after you pay \$250 deductible at a Participating Provider

Emergency Room - Greatest Cost

Emergency rooms (ER) provide the highest level of care for the most complicated and critical conditions. If you are not experiencing an emergency, please consider one of the options above.

ER: 80% coverage after you pay \$250 deductible + \$150 copay per visit if the patient is not admitted as a result of the ER visit



The Livongo Diabetes Management Program by Teladoc is designed to provide comprehensive support for eligible individuals managing diabetes, offering a suite of free services and supplies aimed at improving health outcomes. Eligible participants and their dependents receive unlimited glucose testing strips and lancets, a complimentary blood glucose monitor, and real-time interactive coaching with qualified nutritionists. The program is voluntary and fully funded, ensuring no out-of-pocket expenses for members. Participants also gain access to a range of smart devices, including blood glucose meters, blood pressure monitors, and scales, which enable them to track their health metrics, observe trends, and download detailed reports.

With 24/7 expert coaching available, members can receive immediate support following out-of-range readings and benefit from personalized programs tailored to their unique needs. This holistic approach empowers individuals to manage their diabetes more effectively, with all necessary supplies conveniently delivered to their doorsteps.



Sword Virtual Physical Therapy



The Plan offers alternative ways of obtaining care such as online/internet-based physician visits. A new option available for virtual care is the Sword Health physical therapy program. Sword Health is a physical therapy program that you can use at home. If your Physician prescribes you physical therapy, you can enroll in the Sword Health program. Once enrolled, you will receive a kit that includes motion trackers and a tablet.

TEAM provides patient advocacy services by helping you:


- ► Understand your medical conditions
